

Check Your Citations: APA

If you copied and pasted your citations from an article database or another citation generator, be sure to double-check the formatting for errors. Use the citation below as an example:

For every citation, ask yourself:		Example:
1	Is the author(s) name(s) listed as last name, first initial?	Lybecker, D. L., McBeth, M. K., & Kusko, E.
2	If there are 2 or more authors, did you use an ampersand? *You must list all names up to 20 authors. If there are more than 20 authors, list the first nineteen authors followed by three spaced ellipse points (. . .) , and then the last author's name.	Lybecker, D. L., McBeth, M. K., & Kusko, E.
3	Is the publication date in parenthesis after the author's name?	(2012)
4	Is the title of the article (or anything) in all caps? If so, fix this! Nothing should ever be in all caps.	Trash or treasure: Recycling narratives and reducing political polarization.
5	Is the only capitalized word in the title of the article or book the first word, proper noun, or first word of a subtitle? If not, fix this!	Trash or treasure: Recycling narratives and reducing political polarization.
6	Is the title of the journal or book italicized?	<i>Environmental Politics</i>
7	If an article, is the volume number of the journal italicized? *This is hard to spot but still needs attention.	22(2) = volume number is 22 and the issue number is 2
8	Is there only a + sign after the first page number? If so, fix this! The entire range of page numbers should be listed.	312-332
9	Is the DOI (or link to database) the last element of the citation?	https://doi.org/10.1080/09644016.2012.692935
10	Do you have a hanging indent after the first line of the citation? **Don't forget to alphabetize your list of references by the first element of each citation. This is usually the author's last name, but could be a title of a source if there is no author listed.	Use the citation above to see example. To format a hanging indent: PC Word highlight citation and press Ctrl + T Mac Word highlight citation and press Command + T
