The following information is a summary of Chapman University College General Education Requirements and a guide for Saddleback College courses that satisfy the requirements.

GE Block Transfer

Chapman accepts the full CSU or UC IGETC certification to satisfy all GE requirements except LBSU 300 and the JWP. Certification must be completed prior to the student's first term admitted, enrolled and attending. Shaded area below indicates requirements met by certification.

Courses may be approved for more than one area but can only be applied towards one requirement.

Writing and Critical Thinking ENGU 103 Freshman Rhetoric <i>ENG 1A</i>
Writing and Critical Thinking ENGU 104 Writing About Literature <i>ENG 1B</i>
Communication or Critical Thinking <i>CSU Area A3 approved course excluding ENG 1B</i> <i>or *any 3 cr. COMU</i>
Quantitative Skills <i>CSU Area B4 approved course</i> <i>or *any 3 cr. MATU</i>
<u>Breadth Requirements (30)</u>
Humanities 12 credits from a minimum of 3 areas below. Must have at least 2 credits to meet an area
Area 1: English. Foreign Languages <i>*any approved course under ENGU, FLUU, FRNU, SPNU</i>
Area 2: Fine Arts <i>CSU Area C1</i> <i>or *any ARTU, FAUU, FTVU, MUSU, THDU</i>
Area 3: Humanities <i>*any HUMU</i>
Area 4: Philosophy <i>*any PHLU</i>

Area 5: Religious Studies <i>*any RELU</i>
Natural Sciences <u>Minimum 6 credits required</u>
Complete 6 credits of natural science courses. Lab credit is not required. <i>Any CSU Area B1 or B2 approved course or *any BIOU, CHMU, ESCU, FSNU, LSCU, PHYU, PSCU</i>
Social Sciences 12 credits from a minimum of 3 areas below. Must have at least 2 credits to meet an area
Area 1: Economics/Organizational Leadership <i>*any ECNU or OLCU</i>
Area 2: History <i>*any HISU</i>
Area 3: Political Science <i>*any POSU</i>
Area 4: Psychology <i>*any PSYU</i>
Area 5: Social Science <i>*any SSCU</i>
Area 6: Sociology/Criminal Justice <i>*any SOCU/CJCU</i>
University College Foundations (3 credits) LBSU 300 Complete at Chapman
Writing Proficiency Requirement Met by passing of the Junior Writing Proficiency exam after completion of 60 credits and ENGU 104
