POLITICAL SCIENCE (CSUF, CSULB, CSUSM, SDSU, UCI, UCLA, UCSD)

Political Science is the study of people's behavior as it relates to power and public organizations. A student may elect to major in Political Science as a preparation for fields such as: (1) college or university teaching, (2) law, (3) government career service, (4) foreign career services, and (5) politics.

Listed below are Saddleback College (SC) courses that have been articulated with selected example universities, and represents lower-division preparation for the major. In addition, students are advised to complete General Education requirements prior to transfer.

NOTES:

Ask them to send you information about their Political Science program; selection criteria, GPA requirements, and other pertinent admissions information. Also, ask for information about their campus, services, housing, etc. Meet with college/university representatives when they visit Saddleback College.
