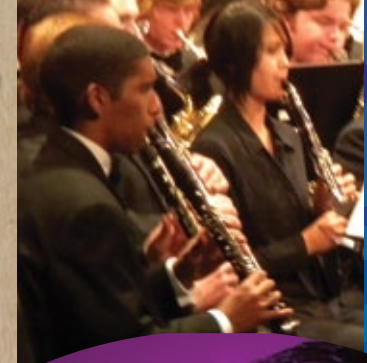
THE ARMED MAN – A MASS FOR PEACE

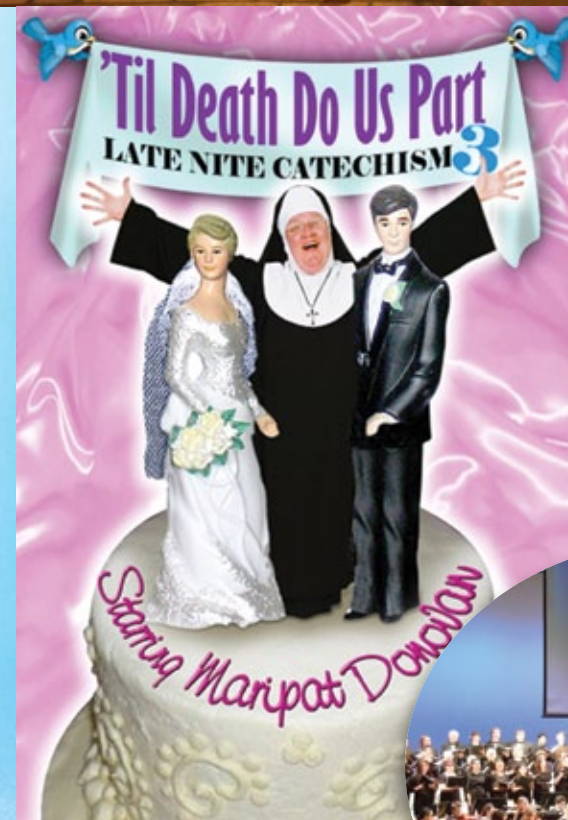

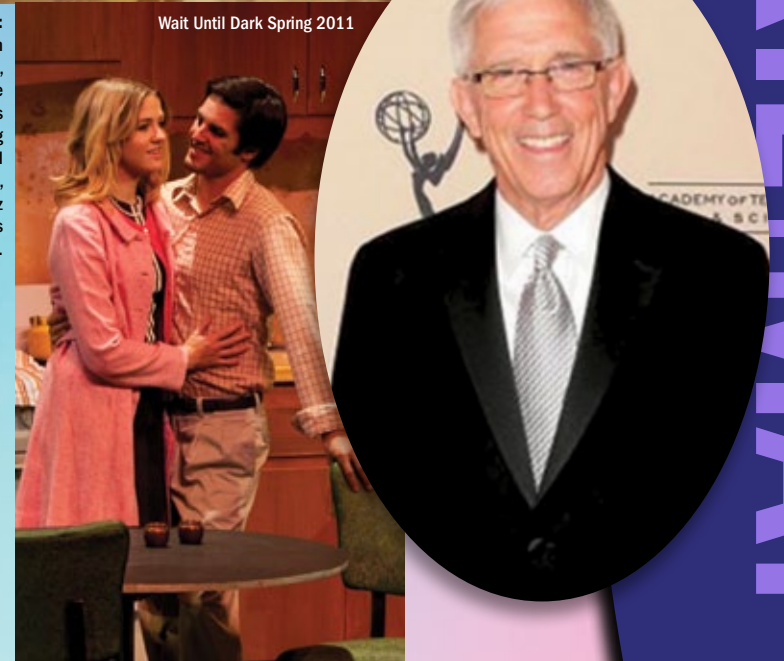

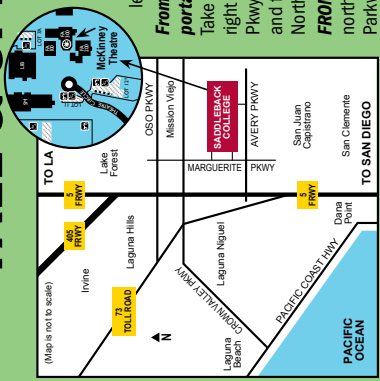
