Whereas, the student population of Saddleback College & Irvine Valley College are comprised of different demographics and;

Whereas, the course work offered at Saddleback College and Irvine Valley College have many differences and draw in different types of students and;

Whereas, the regular Trustees on the Board are elected from specific areas within the district to ensure accurate representation of their constituents and;

Resolved, that the Associated Student Government of Saddleback College feels that one Student Trustee cannot adequately represent the entire student population of both Saddleback & Irvine Valley College and;

Further Resolved that the Associated Student Government of Saddleback College requests that the South Orange County Community College District create a second student Trustee Position so that both campuses can have one advisory student member on the Board of Trustees.
