

Distance Education Committee Goals for 2009-2010

- I. Advocate for the hiring of the Distance Education Dean/Director.
- II. Continue advocating for the adding of more Building Blocks to Blackboard so that we can use more innovative distance learning pedagogies (i.e., Learning Objects Campus Pack)
- III. Complete a Faculty DE Handbook (PDF and Online Versions), including information and resources for 508 compliance.
- IV. Administer the 3rd Annual Distance Education Student Survey – Fall Semester
- V. Complete a Distance Education Program Review to ensure that our needs are addressed and our successes recognized.
- VI. Support the development of online degree and certificates, while also:
 - a. Working closely with the Articulation Officer and Curriculum Chair to avoid putting our transferable courses in jeopardy;
 - b. Ensuring that non-transferrable courses/online degrees are clearly identified and marketed as such.
- VII. Work with the District on devising a Blackboard tutorial that students need to test out of before being able to register for an online class for the first time.
- VIII. Offer the Online Teaching Occupational Skills Award classes (Spring semester).
- IX. Complete and administer a survey to finalize the Online Teaching Certificate approval process.
- X. Refine the Presidium site and knowledge base.
