1. **FLCs can count for either Flex credit or college service hours.**
2. FLC Groups will be limited to 10 participants each and meet every 3 weeks for at least 2 hours each meeting (about 5 times a semester).
3. Meeting schedules will be decided upon by the group.
4. Joining an FLC is a commitment for the entire year (Jan-December).
5. Summer gatherings will be optional and decided upon by the group.
6. Each group is responsible for determining their own goals and outcomes related to their theme.
7. Group Outcomes will be shared with the larger FLC community at the end of the FLC year.
