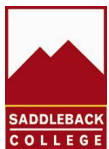

<p>The mission of the Student Financial Assistance Office at Saddleback College is to provide services to students in their search for funds to help offset the cost of their education and thereby help students pursue their personal and educational goals.</p>	<p>1. To increase student awareness of, as well as provide information about, the various types of federal financial aid programs through workshops, websites, online applications, individual appointments.</p>	<p>1a. The Office will track the number of FAFSA applications and BOG fee waiver applications filed for 2006/07. These numbers will increase by at least 5% yearly.</p>	<p>The number of FAFSA applications filed for 2004/05 was 4,965 compared to 5,281 in 2005/06.</p> <p>The number of BOG Fee Waiver Applications filed for 2004/05 was 3,511 compared to 3,576 in the 2005/06. 2% increase.</p>	<p>We exceeded our goal of 5% and increased FAFSA applications. We will continue tracking the number of applications to assure our goal is met.</p> <p>Fell short of the proposed 5% increase for BOG fee waivers, however, data was collected prior to the formation of AUO's. We will continue to track this data.</p>
