

# Animal Rights Club

## Constitution

### Article I- Name

The name of this organization shall be the Animal Rights Club.

### Article II- Purpose

The purpose of the Animal Rights Club is to raise awareness about animal abuses and how it effects the environment and us as humans.

### Article III- Membership

Members of the Animal Rights Club will consist exclusively of currently enrolled Saddleback College students.

### Article IV- Officers

#### 4.1 President

The President shall chair all official club meetings, organize time and location of meetings, organize events/fundraisers, schedule the club advisor to be present at meetings when need be and when money is discussed.

#### 4.2 Vice-President

The Vice-President shall in the absence of the President, chair the official club meetings, help organize events/fundraisers with the President.

#### 4.3 Treasurer

Help organize fundraisers and the money raised.

#### 4.4 Secretary

The secretary will keep minutes at all meetings, logging all of the club decisions.

### Article V- Executive Board

5.1 The members of the executive board shall be the President, Vice President, Treasurer and Secretary.

5.2 The members of the executive board shall plan the events, fundraisers and meetings.

5.3 The members of the executive board must do their share of research to inform and hold discussions at each meeting.

### Article VI- Meetings

6.1 The Animal Rights Club will meet once every two weeks on a day agrees upon by the voting members during the first official meeting.

6.2 A quorum is called during the second official club meeting.

### Article VII- Elections

Elections will be held on the last meeting of every semester.

### Article VIII- Succession

In the event of a vacancy in the office of a position, succession shall automatically occur in this order:

Vice-President  
Treasurer  
Secretary

A special election will be called if position cannot be filled.

IX-Impeachment

A member may be impeached by a 2/3 majority vote of the active voting membership.

X- Amendments

Amendments must be submitted to the executive board and passed by a 2/3 majority vote if the active voting membership.

XI- Dissolution

In the event that the Animal Rights Club should completely disband and forfeit the club's chartered status, then no funds, money or property of value shall inure to any officer, member or any other person, but after all just bills have been paid any assets remaining shall be forwarded to the Associated Student Government of Saddleback College.
