

ANIME CLUB CONSTITUTION

I. Title:

Anime Club
(a.k.a. Japanese animation club)

II. Purpose:

- 1) To show individuals a new type of animation in contrast to American standards.**
- 2) To make people aware of many possibilities of story-telling (other than children's stories) in animation.**
- 3) To show individuals different forms of story-telling techniques and genres rarely shown in animation.**

III. Membership:

- 1) Membership is open to any interested party.**
- 2) New members can partition to the club council during predesignated hours.**

IV. Officers:

President: Organizes meetings and decides on what films are to be shown, according to council polls.

Vice-President: Assumes the position of the president if he is unable to attend a meeting. Also makes announcements pertaining to up-coming events.

Secretary: Records any and all club matters.

Treasurer: Manages the budget of the club. includes : fund raising activities, donations, and other monetary transactions of the club.

I.C.C. Member: Will attend I.C.C. meetings and make reports to the council.

V. Meetings:

Meetings will be held once a week on Thursday from 12-3pm.
Meeting agendas will be announced the week prior to the actual meeting.

VI. Quorum:

A quorum will be 70% of eligible voting members present.

VII. Amendments:

- 1) Amendments must be submitted 1 to 2 weeks prior to the voting date.**
- 2) 70% of the members should be present to vote on a constitutional amendment.**
