## The Constitution of *The Legion of Anthropology Students*

- I. The Legion of Anthropology Students.
- II. To teach, promote, and extend the ideas and events related to the fields of visual, biological and cultural anthropology, linguistics, and archeology.
- III.
  1. Anyone who attends Saddleback College may become a member.
  2. ~~UNMET~~ Membership criteria shall be determined upon the formation of the Legion.
- IV.
  1. Officers shall be listed upon the formation of the Legion.
  2. Officers shall be elected on the second before last week of each semester. One may become an officer by winning at least one-half of the votes of the present Legion members, given that at least two-thirds of the active members are present at the time of voting.
  3. Each term shall last one semester, and maximum of four terms per officer.
  4. Each officer shall appoint a "replacement" member from the club to fill her/his position in the event of that officer's temporary or permanent absence.
- V.
  1. The Legion shall meet at least once every week, when school is in session.
  2. Meetings shall be called with the presence of officers and Legion advisor.
- VI. A formal meeting is held with at least one-half of the active Legion members.
- VII.
  1. The notification period for amending this constitution shall be at least seven days, at least five of which school must be in session.
  2. At least two-thirds of Legion members shall be present, of which at least two-thirds should agree on the proposed amendment.
