

## Saddleback Anthropology Club Constitution

### Constitution of the Saddleback College Anthropology Club

*As revised effective September 2010*

- I. Any member with a sincere interest in anthropology—who has not been voted off the island—is considered to be in good standing.
- II. There shall be no mandatory dues; voluntary payment, however, is allowed.
- III. Officers' duties shall include, but are not limited to, the general planning of the club's programs, and conduction of the meetings.
- IV. The Cabinet shall be determined upon the formation of the club.
- V. Committees may be formed upon the formation of the club.
- VI. The order of business shall be determined upon the formation of the club.
- VII. The club's By-Laws may be amended by a simple majority vote casted at a meeting by one-half plus 1 of the Anthropology Club's active membership.
