

The Chemistry Club Bylaws

Article 1

To cover the costs of the activities suggests by the members the club will rely on donations, grants and fundraising events.

Article 2

Section 1. The officers of this organization shall be provided for in the constitution.

Section 2. The duties of the President shall be :

- a) To preserve the integrity of the club ;
- b) To serve as a messenger among members , officers as well as club advisors;
- c) To arrange the agenda, lectures, and discussions;
- d) To preside at general meetings and meetings held among club officers;
- e) To supervise and coordinate all activities of the club;
- f) To keep an accurate record of the proceedings of all meetings;

Section 3. The duties of the Vice-President shall be :

- a) To make himself/herself available to the President at all times and to perform such duties as the President deems necessary;
- b) To officiate in the place of the President in the event of his/her absence;
- c) To keep an accurate record of all money received or paid out;
- d) To collect dues and handle all other financial matters under the direct supervision of the President.

Article 3

The executive board shall be comprised of the officers and the faculty advisors

Article 4

Amendments to these by-laws may be proposed by any member at any of the meetings. An amendment is approved through a two-third vote of a quorum at such meetings.
