

The Chemistry Club Constitution

In order to form an efficient and energetic student organization to provide a means for various activities for the students as well as our community, the students at Saddleback College who are interested in science, mathematics or engineering, particularly chemistry, establish this constitution: The Chemistry Club.

Article 1

This organization shall be known as "The Chemistry Club".

Article 2

The purpose of this organization shall be:

- a) To provide intellectual discussions on chemistry, mathematics, and other science and engineering topics or problems;
- b) To help students improve their chemistry problem solving strategies;
- c) To present and discuss topics not included in our texts or classes so that students will have a much more profound understanding of chemistry as well as of the other sciences.
- d) To support undergraduate research in science at Saddleback College.

Article 3

Membership in The Chemistry Club shall be open to all students interested in science and mathematics or any subject related to them.

Article 4

Section 1. Officers of this organization shall be :

- a) The President
- b) The Vice-president
- c) The ICC Representative

Section 2. The officers shall be elected at the beginning of the fall semester.

Elections will be held in the following manner :

- 1) The names of all volunteers will be displayed;
- 2) Voting will be by a show of hands;
- 3) The office-holder will be the volunteer with the most number of votes;
- 4) If the election results in a tie, another election between the persons tied will determine the winner.

Section 3. All officers shall announce the terms in which they are able to lead the organization at the time of accepting their positions.

Section 4. In the event of the any vacancy in any office, except the President, the President shall appoint a successor to serve the remainder of the term. In the event of the vacancy in the office of the President, the vice-president shall become the President of the club.

Article 5

Section 1. Meetings shall be held at least every month.

Section 2. Meetings shall be called by the President or the Vice-President.

Article 6

In order to have a meeting at least half of the members and an officer must be present.

Article 7

Amendments to this constitution may be proposed by any of the members to the President. Who will give notice to all members one meeting prior to the actual vote. The vote shall be determined by a show of hands. This constitution may be amended by a two-thirds majority.
