

CONSTITUTION

- Article I: The name of the club shall be called Chicano/Latino Studies Student Association, hereafter referred to as CLSSA.
- Article II: The purpose of the organization is to promote education on Latino/Chicano issues. With these goals, CLSSA hopes to promote a better understanding of the Chicano/ Latino history, culture, and contemporary issues (e.g. education, political events, social issues, health issues, etc). Furthermore, it works with schools and local organizations to encourage students to a better relationship between all students and clubs.
- Article III: Membership:
- Section 1: Membership is open to any Saddleback College student with an interest in participating in efforts to achieve the CLSSA stated goals
- Section 2: To become a member you must fill-out an application at any meeting, and be active in CLSSA activities and programs.
- Article IV: Mesa Directiva:
- Section 1: Chairs of the CLSSA committee shall constitute the Mesa Directiva (Board of Director). The Mesa Directiva shall select the chair person of CLSSA
- Section 2: Chairs shall be elected at the beginning of the academic school year by the membership.
- Article V: Meetings:
- Section 1: General meetings shall be at least twice a month.
- Section 2: Written notification shall be posted in the officially recognized area at least one week prior to the meeting.
- Section 3: Term of Mesa Directiva shall be for one academic year
- Section 4: Vacancies shall be appointed by the Mesa Directiva.
- Article VI: Quorum
- A quorum will be considered 50% plus one of all members. No club business shall transpire without a quorum.
