

## CONSTITUTION

ARTICLE I: The name of this organization shall be "The Democratic Club of Saddleback College".

ARTICLE II: The purpose and aim of "The Democratic Club of Saddleback College" is to develop more political awareness of the political process and the Democratic Party.

### ARTICLE III: MEMBERSHIP

Section 1 Any persons regularly enrolled at Saddleback College who agrees to comply with the principles of this organization may be a member.

Section 2 Membership shall consist of all persons who agree with the tenets of higher education and democratic principles.

Section 3 Members will be required to pay a due of fee of \$3.00 ((Three Dollars) per semester.

### ARTICLE IV: OFFICERS

The elected officers in "The Democratic Club of Saddleback College" shall be :

- 1) President
- 2) Vice-President
- 3) Recording Secretary
- 4) Corresponding Secretary
- 5) Treasurer
- 6) Parliamentarian
- 7)Sergeant- At-Arms
- 8) Public Relations Officer
- 9) Committee Coordinator

Article IV (con't)

- Section 1: At the option of 2/3 of the body, additional officers may be elected as needed.
- Section 2: Officers must adhere to the principles outlined in Article 3: sections 1, 2, and 3 of this constitution.
- Section 3: All executive officers must be registered to vote.
- Section 4: Officers shall be elected by a ballot vote and shall hold office for one year term, or until their successors are elected, or they themselves of re-elected.
- Section 5: All unexpected vacancies shall be filled by appointments with 2/3 (two-thirds) consensus of members in good standing-as prescribed in Article 3, Sections 1,2, and 3 of this constitution.

ARTICLE V: MEETINGS

- Section 1: Meetings of "The Democratic Club Of Saddleback College" shall be held every week on Wednesday at 2:00 pm, unless otherwise called, in cases of emergencies, by the President.

ARTICLE VI: EXECUTIVE BOARD

- Section 1 The Executive Board members normally consist of all elected officers of this organization.

ARTICLE VII: QUORUM

- Section 1: 2/3 of the members in good standing in this organization shall constitute a quorum.

ARTICLE VIII: COMMITTEES

- Section 1: Membership, Constitution, Elections, Entertainemnt, Fund-Raising and any others created by the organization.
