

1 Name of Organization

This Organization is of type Users Group, and has been named Saddleback *N*X Users Group, where *N*X (*nŭks*) represents UNIX, UNIX-derivatives, and UNIX-clones. This Organization's abbreviated name is SNXUG (*snŭks-ugh*) and will be referred to as this from here on.

2 Purpose of Organization

The Primary Purpose of SNXUG is to increase general awareness, interest, knowledge and usage of UNIX, UNIX-derivatives, and UNIX-clones.

The Secondary Purpose of SNXUG is to assist all members by providing the tools necessary to accomplish the Primary Purpose.

The Tertiary Purpose of SNXUG is to lobby and research methods to integrate *N*X into everyday Life at Saddleback College.

3 Membership

Membership in SNXUG is available to all Saddleback Students and will not be restricted on the basis of age, disability, ethnicity, gender, sexual orientation, operating system bias, national origin, (lack of) religion or genetic structure.

SNXUG is and always will be an open entry/exit Organization with no membership dues. You must come at least twice a month to retain User status, otherwise you will be designated Guest. You need User status to petition for access to SNXUG's system boxes.

4 Officers

As the Primary Founder of SNXUG, I will retain a Primary *r00t* (*r00t*) status, designating myself *r00t*[0], where *r00t* is the root user in SNXUG's primary system box (es). Future Presidents will be designated *r00t*[1], *r00t*[2], ..., *r00t*[n].

As *r00t*[0] I designate Superuser status to the Secondary Founders of SNXUG who will retain *sudo*[0], *sudo*[1], and *sudo*[2] respectfully. Future Vice Presidents, Secretaries, and Treasurers will receive *sudo*[n] in the order of their rank and their seniority.

As *r00t*[0] I designate honorary Superuser status to the SNXUG Advisor and all subsequent Advisors and they will retain a private Superuser label, *advisor*[n].

As r00t[0] I designate user[n] to regular members of SNXUG where n represents the order in which you joined.

As r00t[0], I dictate free elections per position upon the sudden departure, alien abduction, or defection to the Dark Side (Redmond), of any Executive Officer or any such Officer finishing their semester term.

Elections for Executive Officers and Directors will occur on the third week of every Semester on a date set by the incumbent Administration and will begin by nomination and an informal speech followed by a traditional democratic majority vote from the current Users base, of which at least 2/3 must be present to have a quorum. If a candidate fails to receive a majority of User votes, a run off election will be held between the two candidates that received the most votes.

4.1 Executive Officers

4.1.1 President

- Schedule meetings/events with appropriate college offices;
- Call all SNXUG meetings to order and preside over them;
- Prepare meeting agendas;
- Represent SNXUG on campus;
- Form Task SubGroups and special Task positions when needed;
- Maintain communication with advisor[n];
- Manage organization promotion and publicity of events;
- Maintain role call at meetings;

4.1.2 Vice President

- Preside over meetings in the absence of the President;
- Senior Programmer of SNXUG system boxes;
- Senior Technician of SNXUG system boxes;

4.1.3 Secretary

- Preside over meeting in the absence of the President and Vice President
- Maintain an accurate record of all Organization meetings;
- Post agendas and minutes for Saddleback student body within 48 hours after regular membership or leadership meetings;
- Maintain membership directory;
- Help create and distribute Organization memos and announcements;

4.1.4 Treasurer

- Preside over meeting in the absence of the President, Vice President and Secretary
- Maintain accurate record of Organization transactions;
- Develop Organization monthly budget and present it to members;
- Coordinate fundraising events;
- Solicit additional funding if needed from the Associated Student Government in conjunction with the President;

4.2 Directive Officers

4.2.1 ICC Representative

- Represent SNXUG at all Saddleback Inter-Club Council Meetings;
- Provide members with information given at Inter-Club Council Meetings;
- Attend all Inter-Club Council activities;
- If there is no ICC Representative then another Officer must assume the role;
