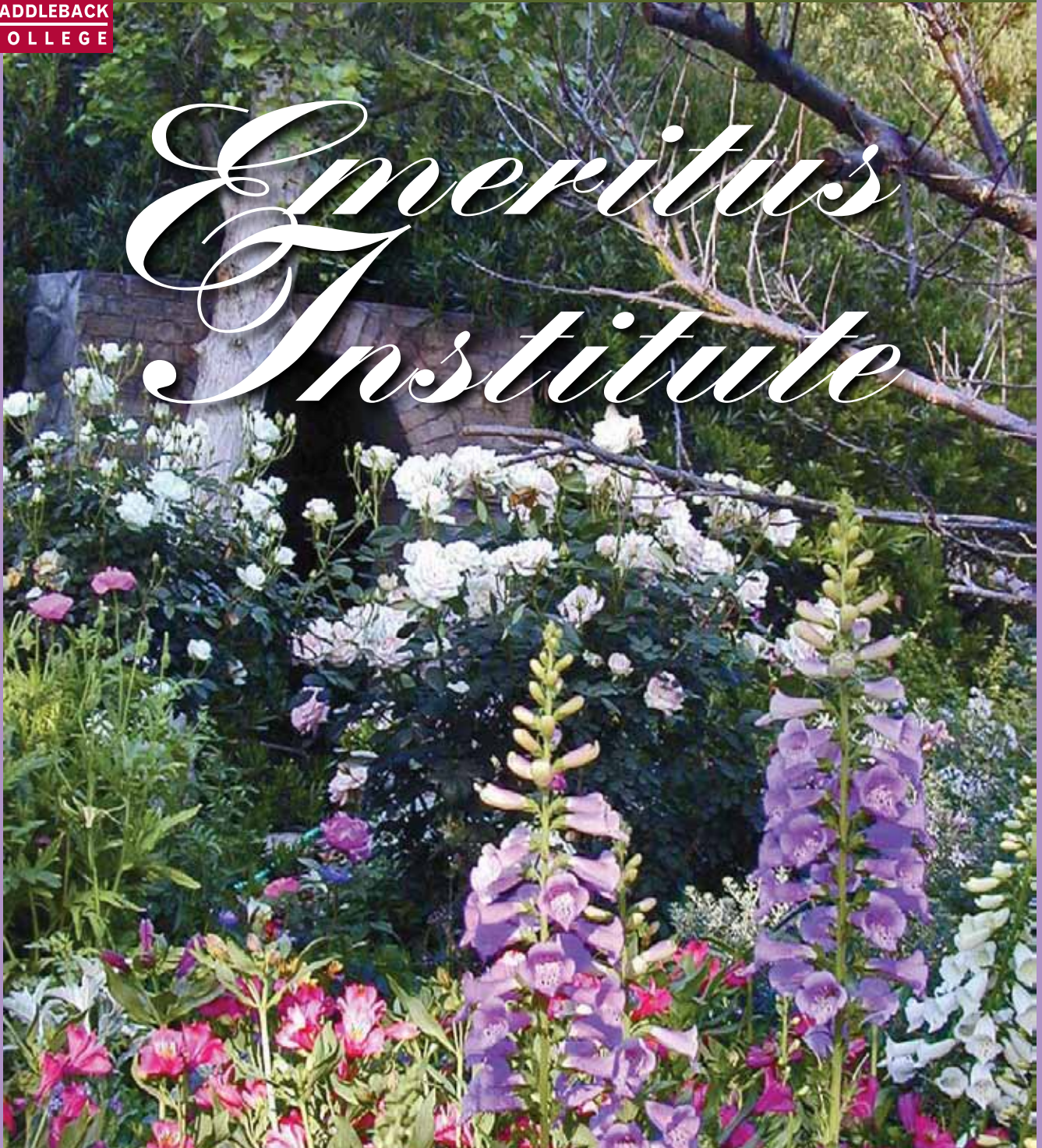

2 REGISTRATION You may register for classes once your assigned Registration period begins. To obtain your registration information:

- **CONTINUING EMERITUS STUDENTS:** Just prior to registration, you will automatically be mailed a "Permit to Register" from the SC Admissions Office. You may also log onto MySITE at www.saddleback.edu and look under *My Appointments* to view the start date of your registration period.
- **NEW (or Returning) EMERITUS STUDENTS:** Once the Admissions Office receives your Application you will be mailed a "Permit to Register." This also contains registration information.

SPRING REGISTRATION DATES

Nov. 15 ... Permits to Register Appointments for *Continuing Students* begin.

Dec. 12 ... Permits to Register Appointments for *Returning and New Students* begin.

Throughout the registration period, computers are available for online registration at the Saddleback College campus, 28000 Marguerite Pkwy, Mission Viejo. You may go to the *Admissions & Records Office* in the Student Services Center, Rm. 102 (SSC 102). Hours of operation are: Monday through Thursday, 9 am to 6 pm; Friday, 9 am to 12 noon.

You are a **NEW STUDENT** if you have never enrolled in classes at either Saddleback College or Irvine Valley College.

You are a **FORMER STUDENT** if you have previously attended either Saddleback College or Irvine Valley College, but have been away for a semester or more. *You must complete a new application before you will be given a registration time.*

You are a **CONTINUING STUDENT** if you were enrolled in classes at Saddleback or Irvine Valley College during the 2011 Fall Semester.

FEES

All fees must be paid at the time of registration. Check or money order, VISA, Discover or MasterCard will be accepted for Internet and telephone registration. Payment must be received within FIVE business days to avoid cancellation of your classes. **Only checks or money orders will be accepted at all off-campus sites; no cash or credit cards.**

ENROLLMENT FEE

The Saddleback College Enrollment Fee for Spring 2012 is \$36 per unit for California residents. Emeritus Institute classes are approved for either 0 units, .5 units or 1 unit. Accordingly, Emeritus Institute classes will either have no fee or a fee of \$18 or \$36. To determine the fee that will be assessed, refer to the units listed for each class in the following Schedule of Classes.

MATERIALS FEE

Students are required to pay any "Materials Fee" as stated for each course, where applicable, in the Schedule of Classes. Additional supply fees may be required.

REFUND DEADLINE

Classes must be dropped by **Jan. 22** to receive a refund.

LAGUNA WOODS VILLAGE PARKING PASSES

Saddleback College no longer distributes Parking Passes for students taking classes within Laguna Woods Village.

STUDENT PARKING FEE

The Golden Rain Foundation of Laguna Woods Village approved resolution 90-10-31 that requires non-resident students who drive a vehicle into the community to pay a "Student Parking Pass Fee," which is \$20 per vehicle for the Spring Semester. There are no refunds for parking passes.

Students who will be carpooling into the LWV Community will not need a Parking Pass. Students who will be walking in will need to arrange for "GATE CLEARANCE" with an Emeritus staff member.

PAYMENT / PICK-UP

Student Parking Passes will be available for payment and pick-up at the Laguna Woods Village Community Center, 24351 El Toro Road, Laguna Woods, from Tuesday, Jan. 3 through Friday, Jan. 6; and from Monday, Jan. 9 through Friday, Jan. 13. Hours are 8:30 am – 2:00 pm. Passes will not be mailed. Students registering late will need to have a Saddleback Emeritus Institute Parking Pass Application Form completed by a Saddleback College staff member before purchasing a parking pass.
