This assignment will provide the student with an excellent opportunity to explore course requirements in order to obtain an Associate Degree, transfer to a CSU – California State University campus, UC – University of California campus, a Private University, or an out of state university. Please complete the appropriate form based on where your transfer objective is going to be.

In addition, complete the semester to semester plan form which should indicate your tentative plan of action for the required courses you must complete before obtaining an associate degree or transferring to a 4-year university or college. You are to plan a tentative semester by semester course of study for your entire remaining time at Saddleback College. Start with the current semester. Include all classes you plan to take to meet all of your educational goals while at this college. Include a listing of any previous academic history in the provided section of this semester to semester form.

Include a copy of the articulation agreement. This agreement can be obtained from the Saddleback College Catalog or by the on-line website www.assist.org. Make sure to attach a copy of the articulation agreement to your Academic Plan.
