

Biology 3A Annotated Bibliography

Over the next few weeks you are going to work on the Introduction and Discussion sections of a scientific paper. In order to write these sections, you must first have a bibliography. Your assignment is to find five primary literature papers in an area of pollination ecology. You won't actually use these to write an Introduction, but they must be related to a single topic area.

The format for the citations in the annotated bibliography must include:

1. Full citation of the paper (name-year system).
2. Brief statement of the hypothesis tested by the authors.
3. Brief statement of the outcome of the research.

Finally, please provide the second page of each journal article cited and a statement of the hypothesis (or question) that relates these papers.
