Before beginning this assignment, please download and READ the sample introduction. The sample is an Introduction from a recent journal article. Answer each of the following questions as completely as possible. All answers must be TYPED!

1. Create an outline for this Introduction.
2. What is the hypothesis (or hypotheses) being tested?
3. Alphabetically list the journal articles, by author and year, cited in this Introduction.
4. What is the total number of citations in this Introduction?
5. What is the oldest citation? What is the newest citation?
6. How many paragraphs are present in this Introduction?
7. List the scientific names that appear in this Introduction, sorted by Class (i.e. Class Mammalia, Class Aves, etc.)
8. Beginning with the first paragraph, write a short statement indicating how each paragraph in this Introduction is related to the hypothesis you stated in question number 2.
