**1. President's Update**

**2. Governance Group Updates**

- ASG (Delainey Taylor)  
The Associated Student Government has been working on creating categories and criteria for the 2010 ASG scholarships. ASG will also be hosting a blood drive February 23rd and 24th in SSC 212 and they are preparing for elections in mid April. He also gave an update on the discussion that took place regarding the letter to Jack Scott and noted that a more in depth discussion will take place. **5. Efficiencies (Rajen Vurdien)**

Rajen handed out the Saddleback College Proposed Efficiencies (for College-wide discussion), as well as, overview, purpose and definition of terms. Discussion ensued and input/recommendations and changes were made.

**6. Planning Budget Steering Committee (Carol Hilton)**

- Priority Registration for Veterans  
Carol reported that currently 321 Vets are taking advantage of priority registration and that the local colleges that are offering priority registration have no time limitations. Discussion took place regarding the additional information provided and Saddleback College offering additional years of priority registration to Veterans.

Move to approve 10 years of Priority Registration for Saddleback College Veterans and revisit this recommendation in one year.

**7. Strategic Planning (Carol Hilton)**

Carol handed out Consultation Council Revised Goals 2010-2013 Strategic Plan. Consultation Council reviewed the document and recommendations/changes were made.

Consultation Council approved 11 College-wide goals to be referred to the four planning groups to develop strategic directions.
