Qualifying GPA of 2.8 and completion of Eng1A, Anatomy, Microbiology, and Physiology are required to apply.

4. Proficiency in a second Language other than English (languages identified by Chancellor's office or taught at SOCCCD)	Maximum 3 point	Proof must be provided by student (of spoken language proficiency)
5. Assessment and Readiness testing TEAS testing- First time ATI testing will be available through Saddleback College and no score will be counted for ranking purposes except the first passing score . No retesting allowed within one year of a previous test score unless post remediation for admitted students	Maximum 25 points	90 % - 100% = 25 points 85%- 89.9 % = 20 points 80- 84.9 % = 15 points 74 – 79.9 % = 10 points 70- 73.9 % = 5 points 67%- 69.9 %– no points
