Students who complete the "Early Bird" program by May 31, 2012 will register for the Fall 2012 semester before other new students!

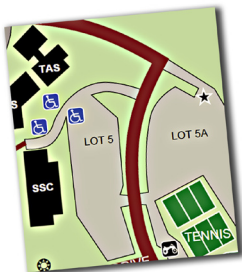
- ✎ Early application period (March 1st - 30th) for the Fall 2012 semester!

Campus Parking

Saddleback College Early Bird Applications for the Fall 2012 semester will be available online from **March 1 to March 30, 2012**. Testing will be held in March, April, and May.

1. Complete the Saddleback College online application for Early Birds. Make sure you select the **High School Early Birds Fall 2012** as the term when applying.
NOTE: If you have problems with the online application or have not received your student ID number within 24 hours of submitting your application, please call the Admissions and Records Office at 949-582-4555.
2. Once you have received your Saddleback College student ID number via e-mail you can continue on to the 2012 Early Bird online date selection process. Go to this website address **www.saddleback.edu/earlybird/** and click on **Step 2 "selecting a testing time and date"**. You will be asked to sign in to your MySite account first, then select a testing date from the Early Bird test menu.
3. Once you have successfully selected a test date it will be listed on your MySite Appointments page. **NOTE: If you miss your appointment date or you need to change your appointment, please repeat the instructions in Step 2.**
4. Complete the Saddleback College Online Orientation. Sign in to MySite and from the menu on the left, click on **My Information>Matriculation>Online Orientation**. Click on either version of the Orientation and continue through all 6 sections making sure that you answer all 10 questions. <http://mysite.saddleback.edu>
5. Attend your assigned date for Assessment testing. **Arrive early and you must bring a photo ID, pencil, and know your Saddleback College student ID number.** If you miss your assigned testing date, please repeat Step 2 listed above. **Early Bird tests are limited so please select a date you are able to attend.**
6. After you have completed testing and verified that you have course placement in your MySite, complete **the Online Advisement**. More information regarding Student Advisement will be announced in the testing session.
7. Register for classes! Check your MySite in July for your early registration date under **My Information and Appointments**: <http://mysite.saddleback.edu>
