



**Attention students. Please read carefully.
This could have a significant impact on your classes.**

Beginning Spring 2012 semester, California law will change and students will be limited to 3 enrollments in a course. Students will be allowed more than one enrollment in a course only if they received a substandard grade (D, F, NP) or W (withdrawal) for a maximum of 3 enrollments. This policy will not have an impact on those courses that are designated in the college catalog as repeatable.

Two things to be considered immediately:

1. If you are attempting a class for the third time this semester (Fall 2011), it is imperative that you pass the class or drop by the “Last Day to Drop without a W.” (To find the last day to drop, locate your class in the online schedule, and click on the “Details” link.)
2. If you were planning to take a course in Spring 2012 that you have already attempted at least 3 times, you will not be able to enroll for the class.
