



## Child Development Training Consortium: What can it do for you?





The CDTC is a statewide program funded by the California Department of Education, Child Development Division with Federal Block Grant Child Care and Development Quality Improvement Funds. Here's how we use those funds for our Child Development Majors at Saddleback College:

To be eligible for any of the three services, students must be:

1. A declared Child Development Major **AND**
2. Seeking a new, or maintaining a currently held Child Development Permit.
3. Employed by a child care/development program at the time of enrollment, including licensed family childcare and out-of-school care. Center-based programs must be licensed or eligible for an exemption according to (DSS) regulations. Employment in a kindergarten classroom is acceptable. Employment experience must be acceptable to the California Commission on Teacher Credentialing for purposes of obtaining a Child Development Permit, even if experience is not required for the permit.
4. Student must work in the state of California.

**Note:** In-home care providers (nannies) are not eligible. Unlicensed, exempt, home-based child care providers (individuals) are not eligible.
