Teacher Assistant Intern

Teacher assistant interns will work as assistants to the classroom teachers providing activities and care for children ages 2-6. Students in CD 110 and 121 may use the internship hours to meet their lab requirement as teacher assistants.

Specialized Assistant Intern

Specialized assistants are students from other majors such as Horticulture, Art, Nutrition, or Aquaculture, who are interested in applying their talents and skills in early childhood settings, assisting teachers with outdoor environments, developing projects with different art mediums, assisting with snack and meal components, and assisting with science observation areas.

- a paragraph describing your preparation and experience that would make you a successful candidate for this position
- a copy of your MySite academic record
