2. REQUIREMENTS FOR TRANSFERRING TO SAN FRANCISCO STATE UNIVERSITY

- † Upper Division Transfer ONLY: 60 semester (90 quarter) units are required for upper division transfer. Students with fewer units cannot transfer. Courses must be completed in Spring for Fall 2007 admission.
- † GE requirements include the Four Basic Subjects with a grade of C or better;
 1. Oral Communication (A1),
 2. Written Communication (A2),
 3. Critical Thinking (A3),
 4. Quantitative Reasoning (B4)
- † You must have an overall GPA of 2.0 or better (2.4 for non-California residents) based on all transferable coursework. Impacted majors require a higher GPA.

4. MAKE YOUR TRANSFER TIMELY! PLAN AHEAD TO GRADUATE!

- † Check with the transfer center at your school to review which classes will transfer and count towards your GE requirements or your major pre-requisites. You can also investigate this on your own at www.assist.org.
- † Use the resources your community college and SFSU offer to make your transition go smoothly.
- † Once you have applied to SFSU, send official transcripts as soon as they ask!! Make sure to send final transcripts after you complete your final classes before transferring.
- † Make copies of all your paperwork, school records, transcripts, and keep them in a file. Bring these papers to all your advising appointments.

If you plan to attend: Priority Filing Period:

Fall 2007: **Oct. 1- Nov. 30, 2006**

Spring 2008: **August 1-31, 2007**

We encourage you to fill out your application for enrollment during the Priority Filing Period. Impacted Majors and Cinema will accept applications ONLY from Oct 1st-Nov 30th. BECA will accept applications between Oct 1st - Nov 30th and August 1 -31st. For all other majors, if space remains after the priority filing period, we still accept applications. **The FINAL DEADLINE FOR FALL 2007 is March 15, 2007.** To apply, fill out an on-line application at www.csumentor.edu and pay a \$55 fee. If low-income CA resident, apply for a fee waiver on the web. Also check your eligibility to enroll in Educational Opportunity Program at www.sfsu.edu/~eop or call 415.338.2016.

Financial Aid Deadlines for 2006-07

1. Federal & State Financial Aid Priority Filing: January 1-March 2, 2007. Fill out your financial aid application on the web at: www.fafsa.ed.gov. The school code for SFSU on the FAFSA form is: 001154. FAFSA has a rolling application, but don't wait, you might miss out!

2. Private Scholarships: Varied dates for each scholarship. Ask the foundation or check www.sfsu.edu/~finaid/scholarships.
