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START YOUR ENGINES

- Take an Applied Psychology course at Saddleback College.
- Visit the Transfer Center and the Career Center.

DIRECTIONS



- Speak to representatives from UCs, CSUs, In-State Private and Out-of-State colleges/universities by appointment in the Transfer Center.
- Attend college fairs and speak to representatives from multiple universities.
- Attend as many workshops as possible. Visit the Transfer Center website for information regarding workshops: saddleback.edu/transfer/workshops
- Research universities with Transfer Center resources such as the internet and college catalogs.
- Contact the major department at the university of your choice to answer specific questions.
- Explore other Saddleback College student support services such as financial aid, tutoring, EOPS, etc.
- Knowing where you want to transfer and which majors interest you will help you choose the classes to take at Saddleback College.
- Completing transferable math and English 1A & 1B should be one of your first goals.
Recommended major preparation classes will often help you determine what math classes and general education classes you should select. Early exploration will help you make better selections for your time, money, and success. Visit www.assist.org
- Contact a GM (Gauchos Mentor). Visit www.saddleback.edu/transfer/GM.html to learn about your desired transfer university.

ROAD STOPS

- See a counselor at least twice a year.
- Have transcripts from ALL colleges previously attended sent to Saddleback's Admissions & Records Office.
- Ask a counselor how to improve your GPA (grade point average).
- Learn about UC TAG (Transfer Admission Guarantee), CSU Associate Degrees in Transfer, and the Honors Program.



YIELD

- File your FAFSA early to ensure a better chance of receiving money for college. Please visit the Financial Aid Office at SSC 106.

Consult with a counselor ASAP

- Apply to a minimum of four universities to increase your transfer options.
- If you have UC TAGs, file your online TAG application within its specific deadline and check the TAG box on the online university application.

TRIP PLANNER

- Once you have applied, send ALL transcripts whenever your universities request them.
Check your email / mailbox for these requests.
- Update your UC application after the Fall term.
- Notify each university immediately of any class changes.
- Complete the supplemental application for San Diego State University.
- Download and file a Petition for Certification to the Office of Admissions and Records. The form is available at the Admissions website. (A transcript request form or online authorization form for online transcript orders must be attached.)
- Download and file a Petition for Degree within the deadline to the Office of Admissions and Records. The form is available on the Admissions website: www.saddleback.edu/admissions
- After you receive your acceptance letters, respond to any additional requests from the college/university of choice.
- Apply for housing as soon as possible.
- File a Statement of Intent to Register (SIR) to the college of your choice.
- Attend Saddleback College's Transfer Celebration (check with the Transfer Center for the day and time).
To receive recognition in the Commencement Program, contact the Transfer Center.
