One science course must include a lab. *Liberal Studies majors (Elementary Education Teaching Preparation) are required to complete 11 units in this category: Physical Science including a lab; Biology including a lab; and Earth Science which does not require a lab.

Leadership and Ethics Core-Specified (28 Units)

Unique to the PCC curriculum are 28 required units of General Education that includes upper and lower division courses in Bible, Communication, and Leadership topics. Sometimes these courses can be satisfied through coursework at other institutions. However, they are usually courses which will need to be taken at PCC.
