IrfanView is a picture re-sizing freeware that you can download at

Make sure you read every step of the download as it will try to install other items. Be sure and uncheck those unwanted applications. Contact Technology Services if you need assistance.

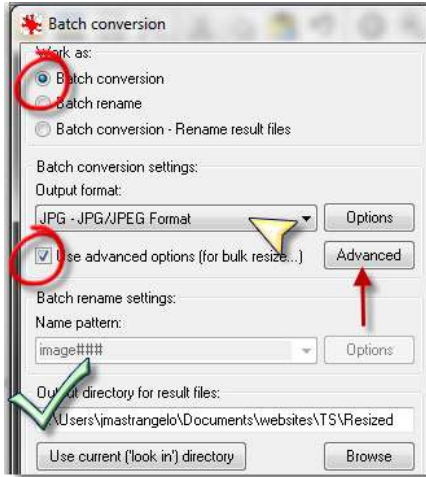
It is a very useful batch picture resizer for the slide show. When you put pictures into the slide show, if they were taken with the highest resolution, the page will lag when opening. By resizing the pictures, your page will load quicker.

Launch the application and then go to file batch conversion rename

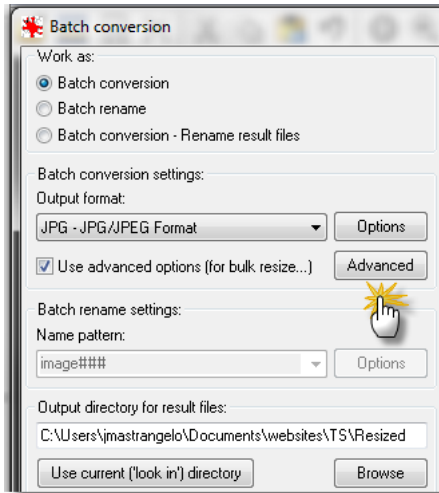


Make sure you have the following options set up. Select Batch conversion, Output format is JPG, Use advanced options, and select an Output directory for the resized pictures different than the input directory.

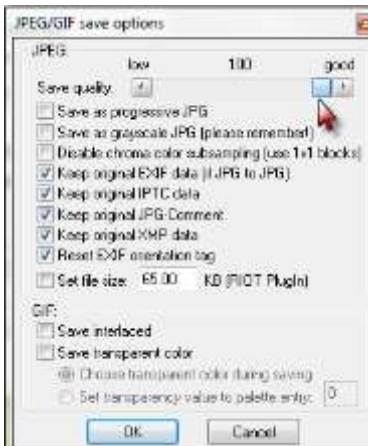

Click on the Advanced and Options buttons

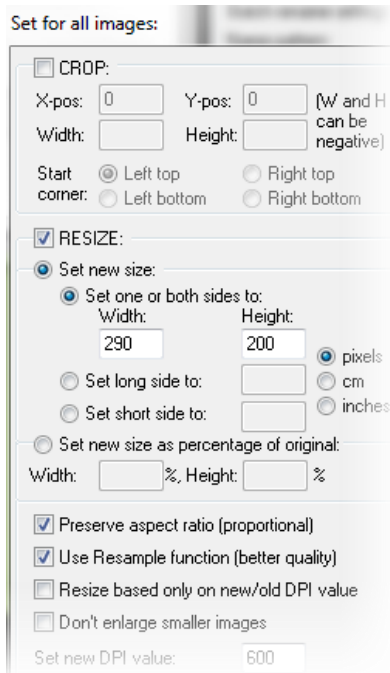


Ensure that when you click on options that the quality of the JPG is set for good

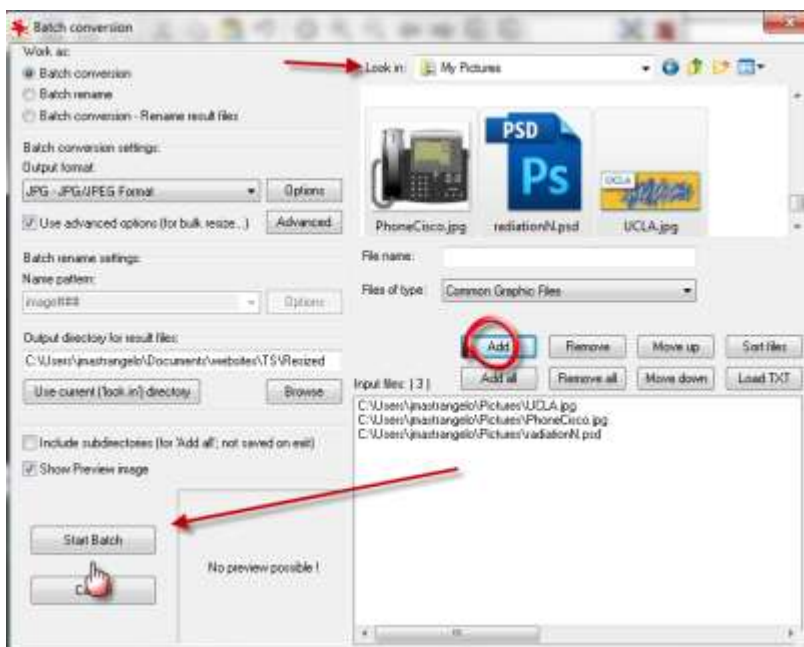


# Picture Resizing with IrfanView

Under Advanced, set the new size to 290 by 200 and ensure the aspect ratio and Use Resample function is checked.



When you are ready, select the pictures from the picture file. Ensure the destination for the Output directory is set. Add your pictures and start the batch.



When it is complete, you will be able to see all of the pictures in the output directory.
