

**South Orange County Community College District  
May 14, 2011 Board of Trustees Evaluation Workshop  
Comparison of Responses on Surveys**

Nineteen items were selected from the long form of the board evaluation to comprise a survey form for the Cabinet, administrations and managers, as well as all full and part time faculty and staff. The items reflect key principles of effective boards and accreditation standards for boards.

The chart compares the percent of respondents who strongly agreed or agreed with the item.

7. The board advocates on behalf of the college to local, state, and federal governments.	86%	63%	54%
8. Board members are knowledgeable about the district's educational programs and services.	100%	49%	30%

10. Board decisions assure the fiscal stability and health of the district.	86%	76%	50%
11. The board effectively monitors implementation of institutional plans.	100%	45%	39%
12. The board respects faculty, staff, and student participation in college decision-making.	86%	39%	22%

13. Trustees refrain from attempting to manage or direct work or activities of college employees.	86%	42%	25%
14. Trustee behavior sets a positive tone for the district	N/A	43%	17%
15. The board regularly reviews and adheres to its code of ethics or standards of practice.	57%	39%	19%
16. Board members maintain confidentiality of privileged information.	85%	47%	39%
17. Board meeting agendas include sufficient information and the topics reflect board responsibilities and tasks.	86%^	79%	56%
18. Board meetings are conducted in an orderly, respectful manner; sufficient time is provided to explore and resolve key issues	100% 43%	57%	50%
19. The board evaluation process helps the board enhance its performance.	57%	40%	36%
