- Refer suggestions and concerns to the Chancellor
- Work respectfully with other Board members
- Hire and evaluate the Chancellor
- Advocate for and protect the District
- Establish policies that implement the District mission and goals, and set prudent, ethical and legal standards for college operations
- Represent the public interest
