READING COMPETENCY <b>Complete Option A or Option B</b> <b>Option A:</b> Completion, <b>with a grade of “C” or better:</b> English 1B, 70 (<i>formerly 170</i>), 180, 190, or 340^ (<i>formerly 220</i>) ^ units earned for English 340 do not apply to the associate degree. <b>Option B:</b> Evidence of one of the following:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. 400 or above on the critical reading section of the SAT</li> <li>2. 19 or above on the ACT English Test</li> <li>3.
