



Saddleback College Medical Laboratory Technician Program Application Instructions for 2017

- Students applying to the Medical Laboratory Technology program must first apply to Saddleback College and obtain a student ID.
- Admission to the Medical Laboratory Technology program occurs once a year during the summer. Acceptance into the program is based on successful completion/verification of admission criteria, the completed application, and the order in which they are received. Verification of completion of all program prerequisites must be included with the application.
- Applications will be accepted from June 5-16 between 8:30 am and 4:00 pm, Monday-Friday. Notification of admission status will be sent during the first week of July. No applications will be accepted before Monday, June 5.
- Program Applications and unofficial transcripts must be hand-delivered by the applicant or applicant's representative to the Health Sciences Division Office. **Official transcripts** must be on file with Saddleback College Admissions and Records before you can register for MLT classes
- A CA Certified Phlebotomy Technician License (CPT 1 or 2) is a requirement to obtain an MLT license. It is highly recommended that it be completed prior to MLT program admission but may be completed during the program.
- **All communication with applicants will be through the email address provided by the applicant on the application, no correspondence will be sent through the US mail.**
