ESL Exam Session takes place in Village 8-5

Arrive on time! Late arrivals cannot be admitted.

Parking: parking permit is required to park on campus. Daily parking permit can be purchased from Campus Safety or the dispenser located in Parking Lot #1.

How to schedule an ESL Exam Session appointment

With your Saddleback **Student Number**, you can:

- Call the Matriculation Office at 949-582-4970 or
- Visit the Matriculation Office in Village 8-5 or
- Log into MySite and use the online Appointment system: click on My Information > Appointments and select an ESL appointment date.

Appointment Day Instructions

- Arrive at Village 8-5 at least **5 minutes before the start time**.
- Students that arrive late will not be admitted. No exception.
- Plan to be present for **3 hours total**: 45-minute Exam and 2-hour Orientation & Advisement session with a Counselor.
- Your exam results will be given to you and explained during the 2-hour Advisement session. You are required to stay for all **3 hours**.

Late arrival policy: students that arrive after the Start Time, will not be admitted and must reschedule for a later appointment date.

Please bring the following items to your appointment

- Photo ID (i.e. Driver's License, High School ID card, Passport, etc.)
- Saddleback College **Student Number**.

Important Information

- Current application required: **Summer 2017** or **Fall 2017**. If you have not taken classes for one semester or more, you need to submit a new application at the Admissions & Records Office before scheduling an ESL Exam Session appointment.
- Students who want to enroll in **ESL classes** must take the ESL Exam at Saddleback College. (Other college exam results are not accepted.)
- Students interested in taking a math class will need to schedule a Math assessment exam appointment for a later date.

- Please plan to be present the entire 3 hours for testing, orientation, and advisement.
- Call if you need to reschedule.
- At the end of the testing session, you will meet with a counselor for academic advisement and orientation. Your test results will be given to you at that time.

Please bring the following to your testing session:

- Picture I.D. (i.e. driver's license, high school I.D. card, passport, etc.)
- #2 lead pencil
- Saddleback student number

Testing sessions will be held in **Village 8-5** (subject to change without notice)

- Please remember that each semester has a specific start date and seats in classes are limited.
- Take the ESL test as early as possible prior to the commencement of the semester.
- Taking the ESL assessment does not guarantee you a seat in class.
