



# Assessment Exam Schedule

## English as a Second Language (ESL)

### Fall 2018



#### ESL Assessment takes place in Village 8-5

*\*Appointment Required\**

**Parking:** A parking pass is required to park on campus. Daily parking passes can be purchased from Campus Safety or the dispenser in Parking Lot #1.

#### Important Information

- Current term application is **required** to test.  
If you have not taken classes for one semester or more, you need to submit a **new application** at the Admissions & Records Office or online before scheduling an appointment.
- To enroll in Saddleback **ESL classes** you must take the CELSA ESL Exam at Saddleback College. (Other exam results are not accepted.)
- Students interested in taking a math class will need to schedule a Math Assessment Exam appointment for a later date.

#### How to schedule an ESL Assessment appointment

With your Saddleback College **Student Number**, you can use the following methods to make an appointment:

- Call the Matriculation Office at **949-582-4970**.
- Visit the Matriculation Office in person at **Village 8-5**.
- Use the online Appointment system in MySite. Log into **MySite**, click on My Information > Appointments > select an **ESL** exam date.  
(*To reschedule your appointment, use any method above.*)

#### Bring the following to your appointment

- **Photo ID** (e.g. Driver's License, High School ID card, Passport, etc.)
- Saddleback College **Student Number**.

#### Appointment Day Instructions

- Arrive at Village 8-5 *at least* **5 minutes before the Start** time.
- Your session will last **3 hours total**: 1-hour ESL Assessment Exam and 2-hour ESL Advisement with an academic counselor.
- You are **required to stay for all 3 hours**.
- Your exam results will be given to you during the ESL Advisement, where you will create an Educational Plan for the semester.

**Late Arrival Policy:** students who arrive **after** the Start Time will not be admitted and **must** reschedule for a later date.

- Picture I.D. (i.e. driver's license, high school I.D. card, passport, etc.)
- #2 lead pencil
- Saddleback student number

Testing sessions will be held in **Village 8-5** (subject to change without notice)

- Please remember that each semester has a specific start date and seats in classes are limited.
- Take the ESL test as early as possible prior to the commencement of the semester.
- Taking the ESL assessment does not guarantee you a seat in class.
