Checking and Understanding Your Assessment and Placement Results

Your official assessment and placement results will be **posted to your MySite with-in 24 business hours** unless the test proctor has stated otherwise. Please check your official results after 24 hours to verify you have placement in Math, English and/or Reading depending on which assessment exams you have taken. Follow the instructions below to access your MySite and check your official results. Matriculation cannot give placement results out over the phone or by e-mail.

Checking your OFFICIAL Assessment and Placement Results

1. Open your Internet web browser and go to: www.saddleback.edu
2. Click on the website link that reads: MySite (located in the upper right hand side)
3. Log-in with your Saddleback **student number** and **4 digit pin code**.
If you do not know your student number or PIN code, you will need to show a photo ID at the Admissions and Records Office (SSC 102) to obtain them!
4. From the menu in MySite, click on the link that reads: My Information
5. Click on the menu item that reads: Matriculation
6. Click on the menu item that reads: Assessment & Placement

You should see all assessment exams taken from at Saddleback College, course placement listed for the exams that you have taken, as well as any placement challenges or appeals you have taken or submitted.

Understanding Your Assessment and Placement Results

The following is a break down of the course placements, levels and possible options to place higher.

| CTEP English Placement Exam | English 1A or 1AH | College level English composition. | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> AP Lit/Comp or Lang/Comp exam with a score of 3 or higher. Other college English course (C or higher). |
| | English 200 | 1 level below college level English. | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> AP Lit/Comp or Lang/Comp exam with a score of 3 or higher. Other college English course (C or higher). Retest after a 3 month period. Writing Sample Final Appeal. |
| | English 300 or 390 | 2 levels below college level English. | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Other college English course (C or higher). Retest after a 3 month period. Writing Sample Final Appeal. |
| | No Placement/See Counselor | See a counselor to assess your English composition and reading skill levels. | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Retest after a 3 month period or look into accommodated assessment with DSPS. |
| | Take ESL Assessment Exam | Skill level indicates that English is the students second language. | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Schedule an appointment for the ESL exam. |
| CTEP Reading Placement Exam | Meets Reading Competency for AA/AS Degree. | This placement clears the AA/AS Reading Competency requirement and also places you into English 180/190 | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Retest after a 3 month period. |
| | English 180 or 190 | College level English Reading. | |
| | English 340 | Additional reading skills courses are required before taking college level courses. | |
| | English 345 | Below college level reading. | |
| | See Counselor | See a counselor to assess your English Reading skills. | |
| MDTP Test Level 1 or Algebra Readiness | Math 351 - Pre-Algebra | 3 levels below college level math. | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Take a different level placement exam after a 24 hour waiting period. Retest same level after a 3 month period. Other college Math course (C or higher). Students scoring above 80% should consider taking a higher level math exam. |
| | Math 353 Beginning Algebra (formerly 251) | 2 levels below college level math. | |
| MDTP Test Level 2 or Elementary Algebra | No Math Placement. Take a different level math exam. | The amount of correct answers on the exam didn't meet the minimum cut-off for course placement. | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Take a different level placement exam after a 24 hour waiting period. Retest same level after a 3 month period. Other college Math course (C or higher). |
| | Math 353 Beginning Algebra (formerly 251) | 2 levels below college level math. | |
| | Math 253 Intermediate Algebra or Math 205 <i>Math for AA Degree</i> | Math 253 is 1 level below college level math. Math 205 is only valid for an AA degree and will not allow you to progress to college level math. | |
| MDTP Test Level 3 or Intermediate Algebra | No Math Placement. Take a different level math exam. | The amount of correct answers on the exam didn't meet the minimum cut-off for course placement. | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Take a different level placement exam after a 24 hour waiting period. Retest same level after a 3 month period. Other college Math course (C or higher). |
| | Math 253 Intermediate Algebra or Math 205 <i>Math for AA Degree</i> | Math 253 is 1 level below college level math. Math 205 is only valid for an AA degree and will not allow you to progress to college transfer level math. | |
| | Math 7, 8, 10, 112, 124 | College transfer level math courses. | |
| | Math 11 | Business, economics, social and biological sciences calculus course. | |
| MDTP Test 4 or Pre-Calculus | Take Lower Test | The amount of correct answers on the exam didn't meet the minimum cut-off for course placement. | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Take a different level placement exam after a 24 hour waiting period. Retest same level after a 3 month period. Other college Math course (C or higher). AP Calculus exam with a score of 3 or higher. |
