STEP 1

GET YOUR CLASSES

- Be sure to mark "Veteran" status on your application
- Collect your DD 214, Military ID and/or Order Papers. Have all Official Transcripts sent to Saddleback College from any schools attended
- Complete the 3-step Matriculation process of orientation, assessment, and advisement (if required): www.saddleback.edu/matriculation
- Make an appointment with a VETS Counselor to complete a Student Educational Plan (SEP).
- Register for classes online through your MySite account
- Contact Admissions & Records for Veteran Priority Registration and Residency issues: www.saddleback.edu/admissions

STEP 2

GET YOUR BENEFITS

- Visit the VA/Educational Benefits Veterans Office website at www.saddleback.edu/va
- Go to the Saddleback College VA Educational Benefits/Veterans Office (AGB 131). You will receive an orientation and complete VA-related paperwork. Allow 20-30 minutes for this process.
