**Freshman Experience/Bridge Program Proposal – Carmenmara Hernandez-Bravo**  
(See handout.) Program for economically and educationally under represented students. Carmenmara's proposal was for a counselor and a clerical support person to coordinate the program.

Many students do not meet the EOPS qualifications but are very close. “Partners in Algebra” has 12 students 6 are EOPS. Mentor program has 30 students half are EOPS. The mentees are well representative of the diverse population.

Last year 40 to 50 students were in the mentorship program. The math program is new. Recommendation for a Counselor could include a graduated amount of time based on the growth of the program.

SSPG recommended a bridge type program in the 2007-2010 Goals and Strategies. The project Carmenmara is presenting seem to fit within the goal but the strategy for both the mentorship and Partners in Algebra programs should be presented on the goals & strategies form.

Carmenmara was asked to include stats and facts about the program and use the SSPG Goal Form to submit with the proposed budget at the next meeting.

At the next meeting the SSPG will review the recommendation for a Matriculation Coordinator and all other previously recommended goals and decide which to include in current recommendations to PBC.
