Extended Times/Attempts for an Exam

The common question of how to accommodate our DSPS students have been around and how to provide additional attempt and minutes in Canvas came up. The steps are simple without having to modify the exam times for all students.

In your course:

1. Click on the "**Quizzes**" menu Click on to *open* the quiz/exam you wish to extend the time for a student.



2. Click on "**Moderate This Quiz**". If you don't see this option, it is because your quiz/exam isn't published. Make sure it is published.
