**Dependents (Spouse or Children):** An additional \$5,000.00 per dependent is required to cover living expenses for dependent(s). International students must submit a current (no more than 3 months before the start of the semester) bank information showing this additional amount to receive an I-20.

The above fees represent the minimum established tuition and living expenses that an international student can expect to pay while attending Saddleback College. Applicants must show funding of the above amount in order to receive the I-20. The I-20 form is the document needed to apply for the F-1 Visa. Fees are subject to change by the State of California and the South Orange County Community College District Board of Trustees. Summer session fees are not included above as summers terms are optional for those starting in the fall and spring. Students starting in the summer must adhere to the same estimate of costs.

**Note: All international students MUST purchase the college health insurance plan.**
