**Cinema Job Placement Rates:** We typically see about 500 students in our "production" classes for CVTR. Then we also see about 1,000 students in our critical studies courses for the study of the arts, film, music, etc. A lot of these students are interested in our courses to fulfill gen-ed. A small handful are interested in a career. These students are getting jobs out in industry but in LA, not Orange County.

The rates are increasing from 25 to 50 to 100 percent, but we **should keep the ISS placement rate the same at 50% in the next year.** We should see how this continues to fare. It would be interesting to see how many non-completers we have to understand this data more.
