Notes: The Dean wants to continue using the Perkins Core Indicator report for tracking historical placements in this division. In the Taxonomy of Programs, the title for the TOP code used for this program is “Radio and Television.” The Dean is trying to add “Cinema” into the title.

CTVR: Cinema Specialty: The department chair set the ISS based on trends across the last three years. The Dean would like to have an evaluation done on the CTVR department because Radio is almost non-existent. Currently, there is a space in the LRC set up for radio courses, but the college does not offer any (we only have the radio station but even that merged with CSUN in 2017). Since Radio is phasing out and Cinema has become increasingly popular, a realignment of TOP codes needs to occur for efficiency and accuracy purposes. The Cinema program would like to offer a new certificate which would be a collaboration with Music and Photography. Many students are interested in Cinema courses to fulfill gen-ed. A small handful are interested in a career. These students are getting jobs out in industry but in LA, not Orange County.
