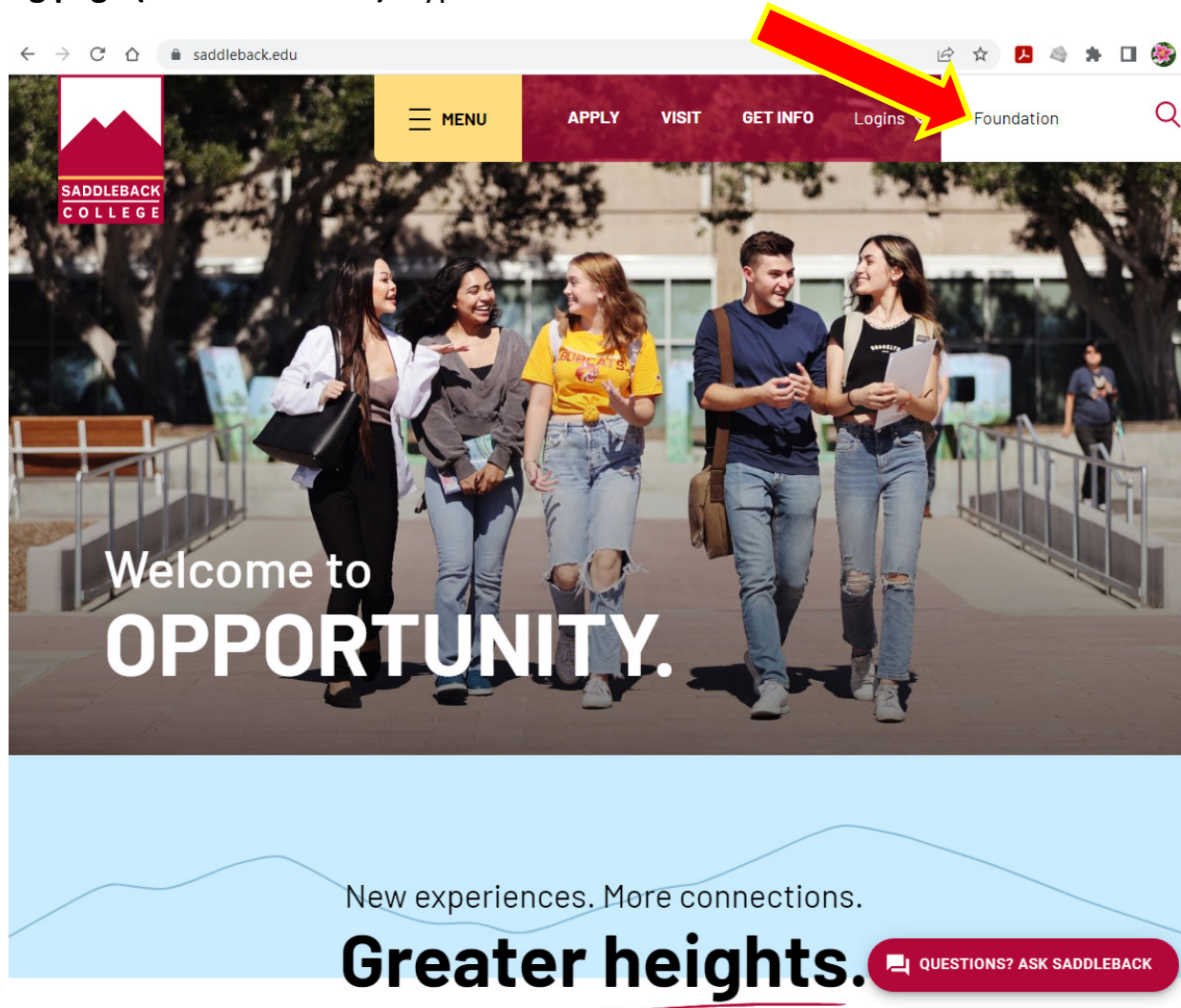

Eligibility: College of Record is Saddleback College, have completed a minimum of 3 units, currently enrolled in 6 units min. with 2.0 GPA min.


The quickest way to the Foundation Scholarship page is from the Saddleback College landing page (saddleback.edu): Type *Foundation* in the Search area.





IMPORTANT:
Qualifying for a scholarship does not guarantee you will receive one. You must be enrolled in 6 units and have completed 6 units at Saddleback College. All submitted applications are awarded based on a rubrics score and other individual scholarship criteria. Please complete and submit all applications by the deadline (2/19/21 before 11:59 p.m.) in order to be considered for a scholarship. All scholarship winners will be notified by email in May. Good luck!

STEP 1:
You must be using either Chrome or Firefox NOT Internet Explorer. To begin the General Application, click the “Sign Up” or “Sign In” button above. There is only ONE General Application, not individual applications for the hundreds of different scholarships.

STEP 2:
Complete the General Application and click SUBMIT when finished. Your General Application will then be automatically screened to ALL the scholarships that you are eligible for based on the individual criteria. There are no further steps needed unless you see additional “APPLY TO” Scholarships listed.

STEP 3:
After your General Application has been submitted, you MAY see a list of “APPLY TO” Scholarships. You will be directed to complete any additional steps. Once completed, submit the supplemental application for each individual “APPLY TO” Scholarship.



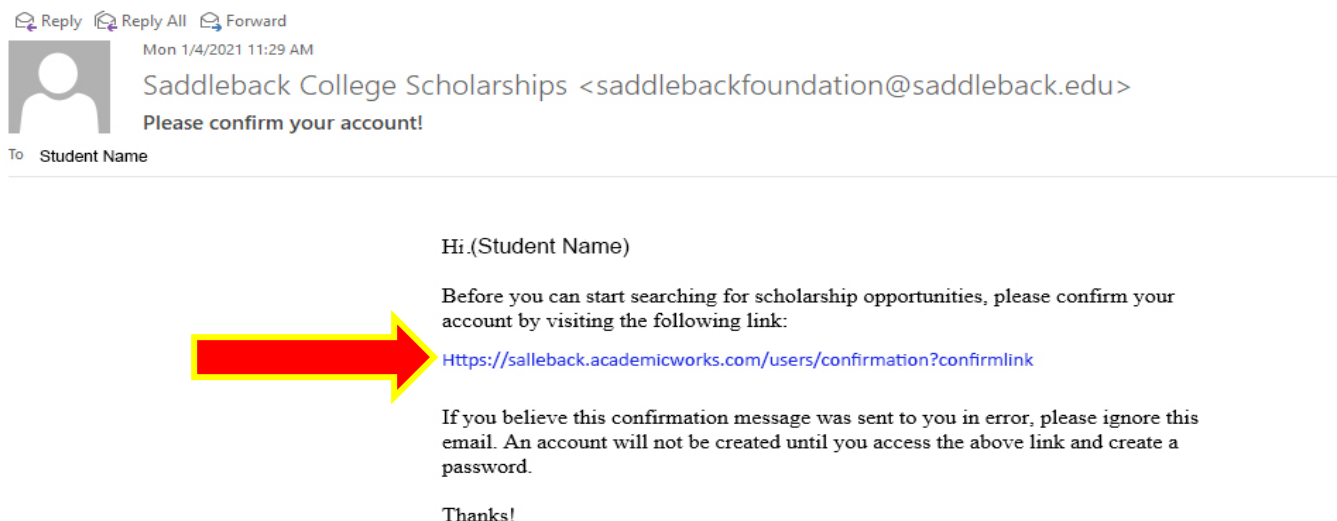

Step 2 (New Applicants): To create an account, first time applicants enter your Saddleback email address, enter a new password and confirm your password. Password must be a minimum of 12 characters, including: 1 digit, 1 uppercase letter, 1 lower case letter and 1 special character # ? ! @ \$ % ^ & * - with no spaces.

Click the button at the bottom of the page and **remember your password** for future access.



Step 3 (New Applicants): Check your Saddleback email for a confirmation email from Saddleback College Scholarships. You **MUST click the link** in the email to confirm your account. If you do not receive an email, check your junk folder.



Step 4 (Returning Applicants): After clicking the “Sign In” button, make sure you are on the “Applicants and Administrators” tab. Enter your Saddleback email address and password. If you forgot your password click on the “Trouble Signing In” link at the bottom of the page.


Step 5: To recover your password, enter your Saddleback email address and click button.


