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Mark Sierakowski attended the Chancellor's Cabinet meeting & brought back the following information. Re Chancellor Sneed:


1. Wants as many classified personnel to attend the Inservice Opening at the McKinney Theatre as possible. Many personnel will be receiving 25 year pins for the first time.

Two guest speakers will talk on the the economy of the state and the economy of Orange County.

2. Safety & Security Manuals are ready to be distributed. This department may be once again be split.
3. There is a \$3 million dollar shortfall in SBC's budget due to raises implemented.
4. All school retirement monies must be placed in trust funds. Ours is approximately \$15 million.
5. No campaigning of any kind is allowed in classrooms during working or teaching hours by any employee of the district.
6. August 2 and 3rd will be interviews for new interim Board of Trustee. 43 requests were sent out and 5 were received. These will be open interviews to the public.
7. The screening committee for the Chancellor's position does not meet ethnic standards. All is on hold at this time & there is no closing date for applications at this time.
