



## CLASSIFIED SENATE

### General Meeting Minutes

2:00 PM • September 23, 1992 • BGS 203

1. Minutes for last General Meeting were passed out.
2. Mike Estes discussed the Shared Governance Model as proposed by Academic Senate and passed out copies of AB 1725. Classified Senators discussed their role in Shared Governance at length, also went over past and proposed models. Submit suggestions and concerns to Mike Estes for agenda item at Classified Retreat on October 7, 1992.
3. Classified Senate voted Linda Wood for Treasurer.
4. College and District Committees were reviewed and edited. Senators volunteered as representatives to various committees. A revised list will available at next meeting or by the October 7th Retreat.
5. The question of registration by alphabet or per units was presented by the Student Services Committee Reps. and discussed by the entire body of Senators. The item was discussed and the final decision was left in the hands of the Classified Committee Reps.
6. The possible hike in Student Health Fees (from \$7.50 to \$10.) was discussed and supported by the Senate.
7. The proposed Classified Senate Retreat was passed by the SCCD Board. President Carroll hasspoken to Saddleback College Administration about the conference release time for Classified Senators and asked them to support us in this event. All attending Senators must fill out a Conference Request Form. Connie McLain will send a brief direction to each Senator or unit indicating what information should appear on the form. The Classified Senate Retreat is scheduled for October 7, 1992, Wednesday, 8:00 am at Cannons Restaurant, Dana Point.
8. Bookstore Committee Reps. Report - Nadine Mendelson reported that the NEW Bookstore has made \$300,000 more than was made by the bookstore last year at this time. Services seem quite smooth. Bookstore Manager Dean Goetz and District Manager attended the Bookstore Committee Meeting to ask about any problems encountered by students during registration and book buying season. 9. A question concerning the PERS funds that were allocated to the colleges could not be answered and it was suggested that Linda Kroner be requested to attend a General Meeting to answer the question.
10. Questions arose concerning the "rumored " eleven month working year. This will be addressed at the Retreat.
11. Treasurer, Linda Wood, passed out Classified Development Information packets. Senators will circulate packets within their work units.
