MEMORANDUM

CLASSIFIED SENATE EXECUTIVE BOARD MEETING - 11/10/93

Meeting opened at 2:10pm by Connie.

I. STUDENT EQUITY - Connie spoke about a document on Student Equality given out by Vern Hodge. The document contains a needs assessment, transfer rates of minorities to the UC and Cal State Campuses, review of existing students, identification of goals, & implementation of activities to achieve student equity plan goals. Goals of student equity mandate are: 1. To increase opportunity for access and success for historically under-represented groups of students and 2. Enhance overall campus climate for students, staff and faculty.

Much debate occurred on both the pros and cons of the document as it stood and the person who will be responsible for implementing it in the future.

II. RACE RELATIONS AND CAMPUS ISSUES - A board agenda item was distributed about the Consultant Agreement for a consultant to accomplish Multi-Ethnic Objectives at the college. Kurt Hueg give a short talk on the Face to Face meeting on November 9th. Many students attended and gave input as to problems encountered on campus. Some of this group wishes to meet with all groups (Senates, Deans, etc.) in the near future.

A motion was made at this time to agree with the recommendation made by Dean's at their meeting, but, in addition, Classified Senate will write their own statement to the President.

III. BUDGET - Budget Committee met on November 9 with 11 members in attendance - guidelines were set up for meetings, times and dates of future meeting set, times of remedial training sessions to be done by Mike Estes and Carol Hilton, and the prioritizing of items to be dealt with at future meetings.

IV. STAFF DEVELOPMENT - Linda Wood read the results of the Staff Development Funding Committee which met on Nov. 9th at 5:30 to select candidates for funding during the next funding period. Both Linda and Kurt will be meeting with Troyce Thome next week regarding a future appearance on campus.

V. SEARCH COMMITTEES - President - interviews set up for November 19 & 20. Chancellor - All candidates interviewed- 5 to interview with Board of Trustees on December 6th.

Mark Sierakowski asked for 2 additional members to work with him for Classified Staff Development day in the Spring. Also want permission to have Market Place on campus on weekends. Up for Board Approval for permits at next meeting.

Meeting adjourned at 3:40pm.
