

## International Students Frequently asked questions

**1. Can I take more than one online class for SPRING 2020 semester?**

In light of COVID-19, Saddleback College is committed to remaining flexible in allowing nonimmigrant students to continue to make normal forward progress in their program of study. They can **temporarily (Only for the Spring 2020 semester)** engage in distance learning, **from either within the U.S. or outside the country.**

**2. Can I drop below 12 units?**

You should not drop any of your classes if it puts you under 12 units. Under the SEVIS guidelines and regulations, enrollment in less than 12 units is still a violation of your F-1 visa. If there are any changes to this regulation, we will inform you by email.

**3. What do I do to transfer to another school?**

Email your fully completed "[Transfer Out](#)" form and attach your offer of admission (Acceptance Letter) and any other forms required by your new school to International Student Office [sc-iso@saddleback.edu](mailto:sc-iso@saddleback.edu). If you are traveling abroad while changing schools, we advise that you arrange to have your new I-20 mailed directly to you.
