ESL Assessment takes place in Village 8-5

Appointment Required

Parking: A parking pass is required to park on campus. Daily parking passes can be purchased from Campus Safety or the dispenser in Parking Lot #1.

Important Information

- A current term application is **required** to make an appointment.
- If you have not enrolled in classes for one semester (or more), you must first submit a **new application** at the Admissions & Records Office (or online) before scheduling an exam appointment.
- To enroll in academic **ESL classes**, you must take the CELSA Exam at Saddleback College. Other exam results are not accepted.
- Students interested in taking math classes will need to consult a counselor about appropriate math placement for their major/goal.

How to Schedule an ESL Assessment Exam

With your Saddleback College **Student Number**, you can use the following methods to make an ESL Assessment Exam appointment:

- Call the Matriculation Office at **949-582-4970**.
- Visit the Matriculation Office in person at **Village 8-5**.

To verify your scheduled appointment date and time, log into **MySite** and click on My Information > Appointments. Your scheduled ESL Assessment Exam appointment will be visible to you.

Bring the Following to Your Appointment

- Photo ID (e.g. Driver's License, High School ID card, Passport, etc.)
- Pencil (#2 lead)
- Saddleback College Student Number.

Appointment Day Instructions

- Arrive at Village 8-5 at least **5 minutes before** the **Start** time.
- Late Arrival: students who arrive after the Start Time will **not** be admitted and **must** reschedule for a later date.
- Your session will last **3 hours total**: 1-hour ESL Assessment Exam and 2-hour ESL Advisement with an academic counselor.
- You are **required to stay for all 3 hours**.
- Your exam results will be given to you during the ESL Advisement, where you will create an Educational Plan for the semester.

- Call if you need to reschedule.
- At the end of the testing session, you will meet with a counselor for academic advisement and orientation. Your test results will be given to you at that time.

Please bring the following to your testing session:

- Picture I.D. (i.e. driver's license, high school I.D. card, passport, etc.)
- #2 lead pencil
- Saddleback student number

Testing sessions will be held in **Village 8-5** (subject to change without notice)

- Please remember that each semester has a specific start date and seats in classes are limited.
- Take the ESL test as early as possible prior to the commencement of the semester.
- Taking the ESL assessment does not guarantee you a seat in class.
